



# Instructions for Treatment with Efudix

Efudix is used to treat solar damage, solar keratoses, bowenoid keratoses and in-situ Squamous Cell Carcinomas. It can be used to treat individual lesions or it can be used to treat an entire area such as your entire face (field treatment).

Efudix is applied to clean skin twice daily for 3 weeks. On some occasions particularly if you have very sensitive skin your doctor will advise you to use it for a lesser period and sometimes as short as 2 weeks.

Please apply it to clean dry skin. You need to avoid using any other products such as sunscreens, moisturisers, body lotions etc. whilst applying Efudix as this will dilute the benefits.

It is quite normal to develop significant redness, some discomfort, a tight feeling and even a burning of the skin whilst you continue to apply it. If you believe the reaction is excessive please ring Fremantle Dermatology on 94304488 seeking further advice.
